Respiratory Services at the Woolcock Clinic



THE WOOLCOCK CLINIC

The Woolcock Clinic offers a unique environment for patients to experience the care of clinicians who are world-leaders in respiratory and sleep health research and clinical practice.

The cutting-edge research conducted here is translated into the latest diagnostics, treatment and healthcare possible for patients.

RESPIRATORY CONSULTATION SERVICES

The Woolcock Clinic provides Specialist Consultations and a range of Respiratory Function Tests with rapid turnaround times for both – usually less than a week of waiting with urgent appointments available.

There are five clinics dedicated to respiratory medicine which manage all types of respiratory conditions such as asthma, COPD, interstitial lung diseases, occupational lung diseases and lung cancer.

- **Availability:** Consultations available five days a week
- **Speed:** Fast turnaround times for tests, consults and reporting
- **Specialised:** Unique diagnostics, e.g. sputum cell counts available



DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES

Our purpose built Lung Function Testing Laboratory conducts all types of respiratory function testing including:

Full Lung Function Testing

- Spirometry with pre & post bronchodilator
- Diffusing capacity of the lungs for carbon monoxide (DLCO)
- Lung Volumes

Spirometry

Pre & post bronchodilator. These are the standard lung function tests that should be ordered at an initial visit for most patients.

Maximum Inspiratory Pressure (MIPS) & Maximum Expiratory Pressure (MEPS)

Tests of respiratory muscle function. These should be ordered if there is concern about neuromuscular function.

Mannitol Challenge Testing (provocation test for asthma)

To be used if concerned about asthma. Also pre- and post-diagnosis.

Adult & Paediatric Allergy Evaluation

Skin Prick Test to look for allergies.

We also have access to further diagnostic and interventional procedures including bronchoscopy, transbronchial biopsy and Endobronchial ultrasound (EBUS) at Royal Prince Alfred Hospital.

The costs of respiratory diagnostic tests at the Woolcock Clinic are mostly covered by Medicare.

Results are reported by the respiratory clinicians back to the referring GP. The consulting physicians are also available for follow up discussion and treatment advice.

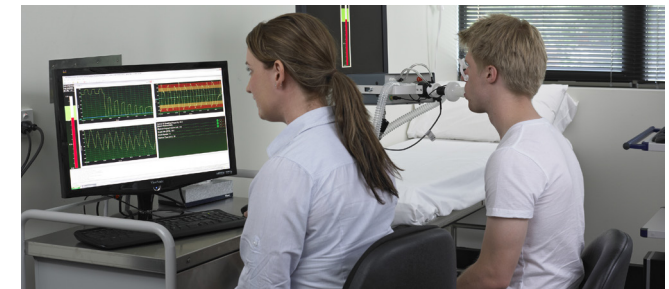
